

## **Proposal for an Amendment to the IJCA Constitution.**

### **Rule 8.9.2.**

#### **Current Rule:**

**8.9.2. Substantive motions that affect the IJCA Constitution ( other than amendments thereto ) to be voted upon at a Council Meeting must be received by the Executive Director to allow for distribution to the Executive Committee and the World Council at least four (4 ) weeks before the date of the meeting.**

#### **Proposed Change:**

**8.9.2 Substantive motions that affect the IJCA Constitution ( other than amendments thereto ), or to the Class Rules, to be voted upon at a Council Meeting must be received by the Executive Director in time to allow for distribution to the Executive Committee and the World Council at least six ( 6 ) weeks before the date of the meeting.**

#### **Reason for change :**

**Experience has shown that a lead time of four weeks is not sufficient to allow for the adequate consideration of proposals for change, prior to a World Council Meeting. This has caused some difficulties and friction in the past , and the extension of the period to six weeks should aid the avoidance of future difficulties.**

**Proposed changes to the Class Rules have been included in this amendment as, at the moment, neither the Constitution nor the existing Class Rules cover this point.**
